Reminder on Hours System

- The Hours System starts on November 1, 2025, for Service Year 2026.
- 120 hours will be required to earn a Service Credit
- 1,000 Banked Hours will give you one additional service credit.
 - o Two Banked Points will equal one Banked Hour
 - o Banked Points will be converted to Banked Hours at the end of Service Year 2026.
- No more earning for two efforts at the same time (double dipping) ex: on duty and training
- Elected and Appointed positions (displayed under Officer Category) receive an additional 10 hours per Service Year. This is a flat 10 hours and NOT per position.
